- January 2006 – San Antonio
 - City of the Alamo
 - Introduction to the German/Austrian MAB to MARC migration project
- June 2006 – New Orleans
 - First conference in the city since Hurricane Katrina
 - Mapping of elements
 - Translation of MARC concise
- January 2007 – Seattle
 - New Public Library had just opened
 - Discussion Paper 2007-01



Process

- June 2007 - Washington, DC
 - Proposal 2007-06 – Required changes approved
 - Dewey Discussion Paper 2007-01
 - Celebration dinner

- January 2008 – Philadelphia
 - Signing of the Declaration of Independence (232 years earlier)
 - Dewey Proposal 2008-01 – Required changes approved

- Authority record numbers in heading and other fields
- Bibliographic record links for set records
- Multivolume monograph identification
- Types for uncontrolled subjects



German contributions

- Geographic added entry
- Cancelled/invalid National Bibliographic Number
- Replacement record field
- Normalized dates and sequential designations for serials
